Q1	<p>Here is a list of teaching areas from which you should select the one or ones in which you will teach. If your area is not listed here please contact the Registrar for advice. You will need to show that you are qualified to work in the area or areas you select.</p> <p><i>Keyboard Instruments:</i> Accordion, Keyboard, Organ, Piano, Jazz piano, Fortepiano, Harpsichord  <i>String Instruments:</i> Acoustic Guitar, Electric Guitar, Cello, Double Bass, Harp, Viola, Violin, Group Strings</p> <p><i>Woodwind Instruments:</i> Bassoon, Clarinet/Saxophone, Flute/Piccolo, Oboe/Cor anglais, Recorder, Group Woodwind</p> <p><i>Brass Instruments:</i> Cornet, Euphonium, French Horn, Horn, Trombone, Trumpet, Tuba , Group Brass</p> <p><i>Percussion Instruments:</i> Drums, Percussion, Group Percussion</p> <p><i>Voice:</i> Singing, Group Singing</p> <p><i>Other practical activity:</i> Chamber Music, Conducting, Early Childhood Music</p> <p><i>Theory:</i> Theory (up to Grade 5), Advanced Theory (Grade 6 and above only), Jazz Theory, Composition</p>
Q2	<p>In order to become a Provisional Member you must be able to show you are a musical performer at the level of Advanced Certificate (Trinity) or 100-level performance music at a University. You will need to attach evidence of your qualification to your application form (a scan will do – please scan as pdf and make sure it is black and white and resolution no greater than 300 dpi).</p>
Q3	<p>In order to become a full Associate Member you must be able to show you are a musical performer at the level of, for example, ATCL, DipABRSM, AMusNZ or 200-level performance at a University. You have two years to complete these requirements</p>
Q4 and Q5	<p>You do not have to have any teaching qualifications to be admitted as a Provisional Member. If you do, you will need to attach evidence of your qualification to your application form (a scan will do). If you don't, you will be provided with a mentor who will support you through enrolment in our Foundation Course. Alternatively, you can study for ATCL (Teaching) or DipABRSM (Teaching) or another course that can be accepted by the IRMT Registration Board as equivalent.</p>
Q6	<p>Examples might be Training as a Registered Classroom Teacher, or a qualification obtained overseas</p>
Q7	<p>If you enrol in our Foundation Course we will try to help you work with these students</p>
